



Our Cross Connection Control program for 2007 is drawing to a close. Our backflow assembly testers have been busy doing annual testing as required by the State Department of Health. A great big <u>**THANK YOU**</u> to all of our customers who have installed the correct backflow devices. Cooperation from our customers has been excellent and your compliance is greatly appreciated!

DON'T FREEZE!

DON'T let that backflow device freeze this winter. Make sure the device is removed for the winter, or is properly protected against the freezing weather soon to return. If the device is not properly stored, it will NOT pass the annual test and will need to be replaced.
