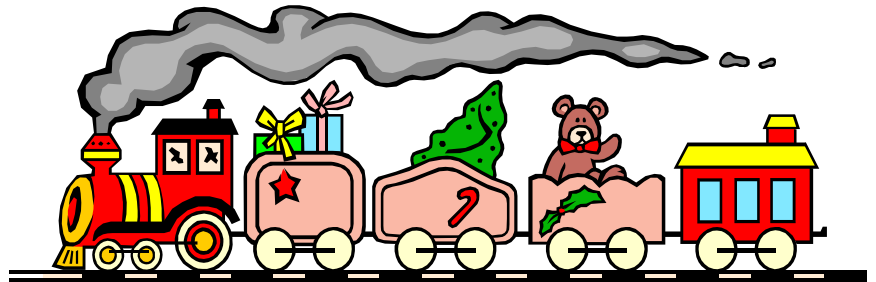

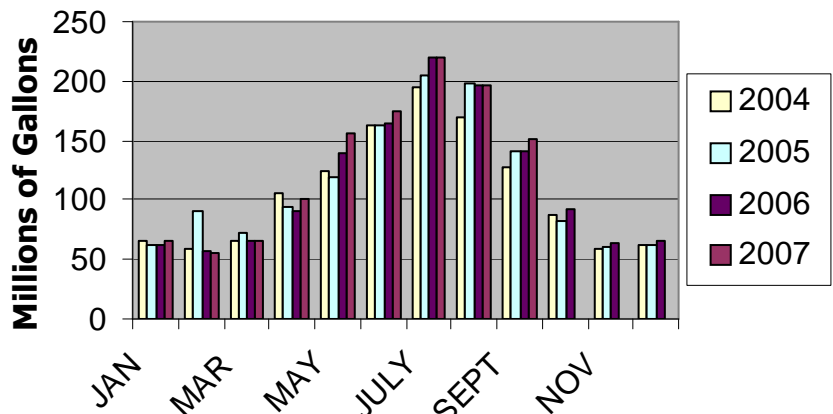

2008 Rate Increase

Effective January 1, 2008 there will be a 6% water rate increase. The minimum charge for 0 to 8 units of water will increase from \$16.92 to \$17.93 for a two month billing cycle. The charge per unit after 8 units will increase from \$1.17 to \$1.24. Each unit of water is approximately 750 gallons of water. If you live in the city limits your minimum bill with tax will increase from \$19.63 to \$20.79. If you have any questions, please call the office at (509) 966-0272.

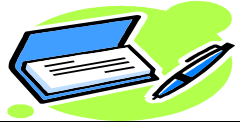


Water Usage History

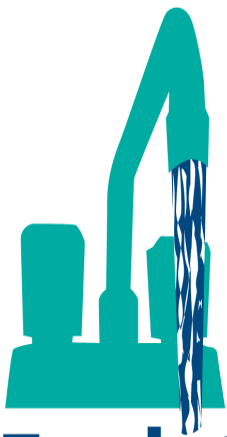




Questions about your Bill?????????

During the summer months, many Nob Hill Water customers use our water to irrigate their lawns. Because of this, summer billing cycles tend to be higher than winter billing cycles. Every statement we send indicates a previous read, a current read, and your usage. If you have any questions about your bill, please call our office and we can send a service tech to check your meter reading. By doing this, we can help you check any possible issues that you might have before another billing cycle goes by. There is no charge for this service.
