#### Minnesota Reservoir Replacement

The Minnesota Reservoir Replacement program has been put on hold until the Fall of 2018. The Association applied for and was accepted for funds through the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund. Due to state budgetary issues, these funds will not be released until a future date.

## Water Rate Increase

Effective January 1, 2018 there will be a 3% water rate increase. The minimum charge for 0 to 6 units of water for a two month billing cycle will increase from \$22.22 to \$22.89. The charge per unit after 6 units will increase from \$1.54 to \$1.59. Each unit of water is approximately 748 gallons of water. *In addition, there is a 22% tax added to all customers within the limits of the City of Yakima.* Customers that use 30 units of water in the City, will see an increase from \$72.20 to \$74.49 for a two month billing cycle, including City tax. The last water rate increase was on January 1, 2016.

# Have you seen our new truck and trailer?

The NO-DES or Neutral Output Dis-Charge System has arrived at Nob Hill Water! The NO-DES system Utilizes a trailer mounted pumping, filtering and rechlorination system which circulates the water within the water distribution system. The NO-DES unit is connected with large hoses between two fire hydrants, which creates a temporary "loop" in the water distribution system. A pump on the unit circulates the water at prescribed velocities where the water passes through a series of filters which remove intentionally "stirred up" sediment and particulate matter. Inline turbidity meters indicate when desired clarity levels are met, taking the guess work out of knowing when the flushing has achieved its purpose. The result is improved water quality and conservation of a vital resource ~ water!
