Minnesota Reservoir




Last Fall, Nob Hill Water applied for a low interest Drinking Water State Revolving Fund loan to demolish the two existing reservoirs and rebuild one larger Minnesota Reservoir located at 615 N. 56th Avenue. In January the Association was notified our project was funded! This project is two-fold. First, this project will be replacing a reservoir that is approximately 60 years old. Second, it will increase storage capacity for the Association over 500,000 gallons, which is needed as evidenced by the last Comprehensive Plan approved by Department of Health. Construction details are hoped to be completed within the next

month.


Nob Hill Water Annual Usage History







It's that time of the year again! Nob Hill Water certified Backflow Assembly Testers will be out in your neighborhood testing backflow assemblies, as required by the Department of Health. This helps to ensure safe drinking water for everyone. If your device does not pass or needs necessary changes as required by law, you will receive notification from our office. Currently, this is a free service for Nob Hill Water customers.



New construction is on the rise!

Nob Hill Water is expanding into Summit View (north of Summitview at 89th), Rainier Court (north of Summitview at 90th), Washington Heights Phase 4(West

of 72nd, north of Coolidge) and Vista Ridge (east of S 72nd, west of Easy Street). Additionally, with the road replacement on 66th from Englewood to Scenic, Nob Hill Water took advantage of reduced fees to replace the main line and service lines in that area. Last fall, Nob Hill Water started a main line replacement job along Scenic from 72nd Avenue to 67th Ave., due to aging pipe in that area. It is anticipated that we will return to that job later this summer.
