


In 1908, Nob Hill Water Company was formed to provide domestic water service to the rapidly developing area on the west side of Yakima. The initial meeting of the incorporators of Nob Hill Water Company was held on December 26, 1908. The company was incorporated on February 22, 1909. The original incorporators were Granville Lowthar, W.N. Irish, Frank F. Gray, A. Helmich and U.M. Nelson. Granville Lowthar was elected as the first president and the first share of stock was issue to W.N. Irish on March 9, 1909.

Rapid growth occurred over the next couple of years and by January, 1912 there were 100 members in the Association. The company continued to grow over the ensuing years and in 1945 the company contracted with A.A. Durand to drill a well (Well No. 1) at South 61st Avenue and Tieton Drive.

As of the end of 2017, Nob Hill Water had 11,481 service connections and an estimated population of 28,450. To date, there are five operating wells that serve Nob Hill Water customers and a possible sixth well coming online during 2019 or 2020.

**Extra Time Needed When Mailing
Payments or When Using Your
Online Bank Bill Pay System**

Keep in mind that when you are mailing in a payment it will take longer for NHW to receive the payment due to the USPS rerouting to the Spokane processing center. We recommend that customers mail out their payments no later than 15 days before it is due, in order to avoid being past due.

We also advise, when making a payment through your online bank bill pay system, that it can take as long as 10 days for that payment to reach us. We recommend that you make your payment 10 days before your bill due date to allow sufficient time to receive your payment.
