

Jeff will present the basics on drip or Micro Irrigation, showing how to provide water where and when it is needed. Micro Irrigation (also called drip irrigation, low volume irrigation and low flow irrigation) is an irrigation method with lower pressure and flow than a traditional sprinkler system utilizing pipe, filters, valves, tubing and emitters. Utilizing this effective irrigation practice can improve yield and quality, minimize water use and protect natural resources.
