Chemical Monitoring Violation—Notice to Water System Users

We, Nob Hill Water Association, Water System I.D. 59700, located in Yakima County, are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring indicate whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. We did not meet our monitoring requirements for the chemicals listed below for the specified time period, and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water at that time.

Chemical Contaminant Volatile Organic (VOC's)

Required From 10/1/21

Required To 12/31/21

Source S02 (Well 2)

At this time, two sets of required samples have been collected and analyzed for the first two quarters of 2022. These samples had no detection of VOC's.

Want to know if your toilet water is running all the time?


We have detect-a-leak toilet tablets at the office for our customers to pick up during business hours. You just take the tab and put it in the tank and do not flush your toilet for 25-45 minutes. At the end of the time, check your toilet bowl. If the water is blue, then your toilet is running more than it should be.

On April 1, 2022, our board of trustees voted to modify our late fee practice.

The new late fees are as follows:

- If your payment is not received in our office within thirty days of the bill date, your account will be charged a \$10.00 late fee.
- You will be mailed a Past Due notice giving you an additional ten days to pay.
- If the payment is not received by the tenth day, there will be an additional \$20.00 delinquent fee and the water will be disconnected the following day.

We will begin assessing these fees as of January 1, 2023.

New Well

We continue to proceed with bringing a new groundwater source online to provide additional supply and redundancy to the water system. Well No. 8 drilling was completed in June 2022, with the bottom of the well located 1,458 feet below the ground surface. Well testing data suggests that maximum pumping rates of up to 3,000 gpm are viable from this well, which exceeded the highest well yield estimates prior to drilling the well. Design of improvements to install a permanent pump and motor within the well, and a wellhouse building to store the pumping equipment will be completed this month. Construction of these improvements is planned to begin in fall 2022, with construction completed in late 2023 or early 2024.
