Wednesday March 15th, 2023 Yakima Harmon Center 101 N 65th Ave 7:30 p.m.





### 2022 Infrastructure Fee

Nob Hill Water Board Members adopted a new \$17 bi-monthly Infrastructure Fee to be implemented starting in 2022. During the first year, 2022, Nob Hill Water **collected \$1,354,721 from customers.** Below is a compilation of how these funds were used throughout the system.

٠	<b>Tieton Drive from Estes Rd. to Friedline Rd. Mainline Installation</b> 1345 feet of 12" pipe was installed to accommodate the pipe replacement on Ranchview.	\$152,291.69
٠	<b>Ranchview Ln. from Friedline Rd. to Estes Rd. Mainline Replacement</b> 1345 feet of 12" pipe was replaced with 10" pipe.	\$112,169.86
۵	84th Ave from Scenic Dr. to Englewood Ave Mainline Replacement 1000 feet of 12" pipe was replaced with 14" pipe.	\$115,387.65
٠	Summitview Ave & 56th Ave Mainline Improvements 40 feet of 8" pipe and 20 feet of 6" pipe was installed; allowing for the abandonment of 980 feet of 6" pipe.	\$101,462.65
٠	Service Line Replacements Replacement of service line from mainline to meter. 162 retros completed for the year.	\$528,214.54
۵	Fire Hydrant Replacement A total of 15 hydrants were replaced throughout the system.	\$72,577.19
۵	Advanced Metering Infrastructure Upgrade Upgraded metering infrastructure from 3G to 4G; hardware and labor included.	\$14,557.36
٠	<b>Tieton Drive from S. 61st Ave to S. 48th Ave Mainline Replacement</b> Materials purchased to replace 4550 feet of 12" pipe. Scheduled start date in 2023.	\$331,281.91
٠	<b>Chestnut Ave from S. 72nd Ave to S. 70th Ave Mainline Replacement</b> Materials purchased to replace 535 feet of 12" pipe and 60 feet of 6" pipe. Scheduled start date in 2023.	\$30,363.36
