Cross-Connection Program

Did you know that Nob Hill Water tests over 5,500 backflow assemblies in our service area? Each assembly is tested on an annual basis to ensure that the drinking water remains safe for all of our customers. This testing and maintenance to some of these assemblies is currently offered to our customers at no charge. Your help in maintaining your backflow assembly is greatly appreciated by our staff and by all of the other water users on our water system. Most water utilities do not offer this service to their customers at no charge. Rather, the customer is required to hire a Backflow Assembly Tester. This annual testing fee can range from \$40-125 per test dependent on the tester's fee.





Nob Hill Water was awarded two low-interest construction loans through the Department of Health's Drinking Water State Revolving Fund for the 2025 cycle.

One loan will be used to update and repair the two Westbrook Res-

ervoirs, located at 80th and Poplar View Way. These updates will extend the life of the reservoirs approximately 30 years.

The second loan will be for equipping the Barrett Well, located at Barrett Road, just west of Mize. Additionally, the Association was awarded a \$500,000 grant from Yakima County's ARPA funding.

Q: I'm moving. What is the process to stop/start service with Nob Hill Water?

A: All new and existing customers can call or stop by our office to update or change account information once you have an official move in/out date.

Q: How do I set up an online account with Nob Hill Water?

A: Easy! Wait until you receive your first bill then go to our website www.nobhillwater.org and create an account. You will need your account number and last bill amount in order to create your account. If you have any issues, give us a call!

Q: How can I pay my bill?

A: There are so many options to pay your bill! You can stop by our office to pay with cash, check or card. Sign up with automatic payments by filling out the backside of your bill and sending in the stub with your payment or through your bank with bill pay. Bill pay can take up to 10 days for us to receive in office, please keep this in mind when paying your bill!
